SCHEDULE 24 – SUB-TRANSMISSION SERVICE

Availability

Available to any sub-transmission customer who contracts with Norris for sub-transmission service under the terms and conditions of a sub-transmission service agreement. Where Norris has provided both the subtransmission line and substation facilities beyond Bus A, the subtransmission line and substation charges will be applicable. If the Customer has provided the subtransmission substation facilities, only the subtransmission line charges will be applicable. If the Customer has provided the subtransmission line facilities, only the subtransmission substation charges will be applicable.

Type of Service

Three-phase, 60 cycles, at standard operating voltages available on the existing 34.4 kV sub-transmission system.

Monthly Rate

Sub-transmission line charge	\$1.01 per kW
Sub-transmission substation charge	\$0.75 per kW

Determination of Billing Demand

The monthly billing demand shall be the greater of the following:

1. The maximum kilowatt demand, adjusted for losses, established by the customer for any period of 30 consecutive minutes (or, at the District's option, 15 or 60 consecutive minutes) during the month for which the bill is rendered;
2. The maximum kilowatt demand, adjusted for losses, established by the customer during the eleven previous billing months.

Loss Factors

The kilowatt demand shall be measured at Bus A where the first transformation is made from 115 kV to 34.5 kV. If the demand is measured at a location beyond Bus A, then the measured demand shall be adjusted for transformer and line losses back to Bus A.

Service Regulations

The District's Service Regulations form a part of this Schedule.
